The Alpine Division of Park City Ski & Snowboard will host an Alpine Officials Clinic on Saturday November 11, 2017. USSA AOs who are certified as Technical Delegate, Referee, Jury Advisor, Chief of Race, and Chief of Course, Timing & Calculations & Race Administrators are required to attend Continuing Education Clinics every two years.
